The Brave New World of Ralph Adams Cram

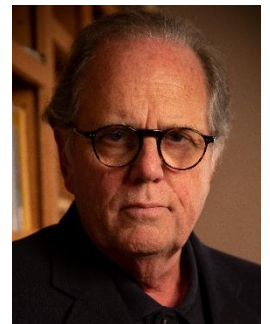
A talk by Ethan Anthony, Principal Architect, Cram and Ferguson Architects LLC

Preeminent 20th Century architect Ralph Adams Cram is perhaps best known for the Cathedral of Saint John the Divine, Manhattan. Based in Boston, Cram also led the MIT Architecture Department. He considered Saint Paul's his "finest small church."

With his associates at the architectural firm Cram founded, Ethan Anthony continues Cram's legacy, designing inspirational new spaces and undertaking historic preservation of Cram's buildings.
